This Tokaji sees only a brief period in barrel, allowing the succulent pear, peach and orange fruit characters to take centre stage. The sweetness is perfectly offset by citrus, allowing the wine to progress from a fruit-filled entry to a clean and refreshing finish.

## FERREIRA PORT

This most Portuguese of port houses is steeped in 250 years of tradition, and gained its current high reputation during the nineteenth century under the leadership of Dona Antónia Ferreira. Like several important figures in the history of Champagne, she was widowed young, and took control of the family business with a gusto few of her male counterparts could match. The Douro benefited both viticulturally and socially from her various projects, and Ferreira remains blessed with a superb range of vineyard holdings from which to craft their range of full, elegant ports.

### Quinta da Leda Vintage Port 1999

Portugal

Mature port from Ferreira's flagship vineyard: the original blueberry fruit is now enhanced by savoury notes of leather and tobacco, and the texture has acquired the smoothness that comes with bottle-age.

## FORTIFIED WINES

### Manzanilla Barbiana

B. Rodriguez La Cave, Spain

B. Rodriguez La-Cave is a small, traditional bodega in Sanlúcar de Barremeda, owned since 1978 by the neighbouring family firm of Delgado Zuleta. The latter was founded in 1744 and is one of the oldest surviving sherry companies.

Wonderful tangy Manzanilla with fresh aromas of green apple and nuts. The palate is light, very dry, yet concentrated and round, with the characteristic salty finish of this special zone within Jerez.

### Monteagudo Pedro Ximenez

Delegato Zuluta, Spain

Delgado Zuleta is the oldest winery in the Marco de Jerez region, with records dating back to 1719.

Dark bright chestnut in colour, with strong raisin nuances, as well as prominent liquorice and coffee notes. On the palate it is very soft, warm and sweet, with an excellent balance between acidity and sweetness, lending it a great mouthfeel and persistence.

### Barbadillo Fino Sherry

Dry & crisp - aged in casks under a floating of yeast know as the flor, using the traditional solera system within the ancient cathedral style cellars of Barbadillo.

This unique ageing process gives this Sherry it's characteristic straw colour, almond aroma and crisp dry flavour.
